



## Prescriptions

There will be a post box in the Whimble Village Stores for people to put in prescriptions and requests for repeat prescriptions. If you do not have a formal repeat prescription form then please write a list of the drugs on a piece of paper, with your name, address including postcode and a telephone number and place in an envelope with the name of the pharmacy clearly marked. If you are in need of an urgent prescription please continue to contact your main contact and we will try and arrange something.


Drop your prescription request into the box in the shop OR contact your named contact for your road and ask them to do this. Please place in an envelope with your name on and mark 'Wells' or 'Boots'.




Volunteers will collect these on **Tuesdays and Fridays** from Whimble village store, please ensure they are there **by 10am** to guarantee they leave that day.



Volunteers will then take the prescription requests to Boots and Wells and they will be collected a **week later**.



Volunteers can collect them from the side door of Wells and therefore do not need to queue. You must collect them from inside Boots.



Once they come back to Whimble we will arrange to get these delivered to you by your contact person or whoever collected them, depending on quantities.

## **Volunteer notes**

Firstly, you are amazing!!

Secondly, I really hope this helps limit the number of pharmacy trips BUT please do let me know if there are issues and it isn't working.

### **Collecting from the shop (Tuesday and Friday any time after 10am)**

Please collect from the shop and place in a larger envelope for each pharmacy e.g. Boots or Wells. I have placed a number in the bottom of the box to be used.

Where possible if you can make a note of the names or number of prescriptions for each pharmacy this will help ensure they are all collected.

### **Pharmacy drop off and collection (Tuesday and Friday any time after 10am)**

- Boots (Place in the back door of boots) and
- Wells (letter box by the main door of the surgery)

Please collect the ones that were dropped last week, for Wells this can be via the side door and for Boots I am afraid you have to queue, but if you can ask them if there is another alternative that would be great.

It would be good to put a shout out in case there are those who have taken their own prescriptions in but need them collecting.

Once you bring them back to the village, depending on the number (and your other commitments) you can either deliver them or drop them to the volunteer for each area.
